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The following maps are attached after this page and show key elements of the Port of San Francisco Embarcadero Historic District:

**Sketch Map.** This map shows the entire district, and its boundaries, and it identifies the contributing and non-contributing resources.

**Bulkhead Wharf Section Map.** This map identifies sections of the bulkhead wharf as they are presented in the text. These sections were originally established for construction of the seawall. They are used here out of convention but do not reflect the actual segments of construction or the order in which they were built. See text in Section 7 for this information.

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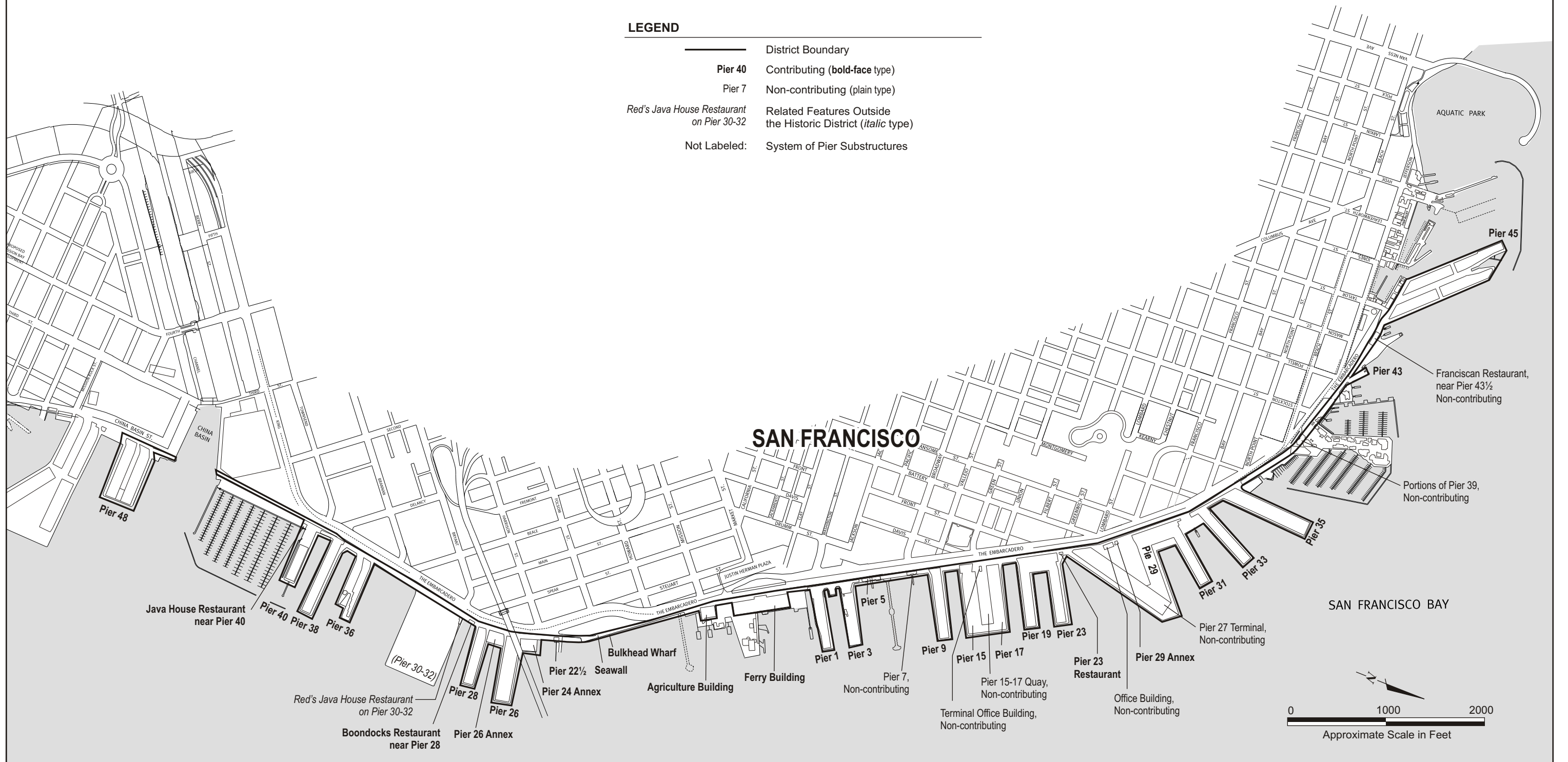
**Figure 1.** Original design of seawall, construction begun 1878. T.J. Arnold, Engineer of Seawall. Source: Crane 1882:n.p.
