Amador Street Pump Station and Roadway Restoration

OVERVIEW

This project will address the aging roadway and pump station infrastructure located on Amador Street. The current pump station and sewer force main is under sized for major storm events causing flooding and the roadway has reached the end of its service life. The roadway will be replaced to meet City standards and the pump station will be upgraded to meet demand.

The construction budget for this project is \$9,600,000.

PROJECT SCOPE

Replace existing roadway cross section to meet current City Standards. Upgrade existing pump station including its structural supports and electrical service. Upgrade existing sewer force main. Upgrade existing water main. Installation of trash capture devices in manholes. Landscaping.
