Traffic Overview Part 1


Shuttles:

- Pick up and drop off operation out of Cow Palace Parking Lots
- Ingress queuing and waves begin at 11:30am
- Egress queuing and waves begin at 9:00pm
- Bus and patron queues on Illinois Avenue

Rideshare:

- Main pick up and drop off operation out of Cow Palace Parking Lots
- Allowed in front of Rafiki lot off of Cesar Chavez for ingress
- No rideshare for egress
- Geofencing to prevent rideshare for egress

Rideshare Vehicle Route

Entrance

- North & South Bound Traffic On 3rd Street Enter On Cesar Chavez
- Continue Straight Through Illinois Street
- U-Turn At End Of Street

Exit

- Exit Cesar Chavez
- Continue Straight Or Turn Right Onto 3rd Street

Staff & Vendor Vehicles Route

Entrance

- North & South Bound Traffic On 3rd Street Enter On Cesar Chavez
- Continue Straight Through Illinois Street
- Enter Venue Gate

Exit

- Exit Venue Gate Onto Cesar Chavez Street
- Turn Either Direction Onto 3rd Street

Shuttle Route

Entrance

- South Bound Bus Traffic On 3rd
- Continue Straight To Cargo Way
- Turn Left Onto Cargo Way
- Turn Left Onto Illinois
- Continue Straight To Illinois & 25th Street Load Zone

Exit

- Turn Left Onto 25th Street
- Continue Straight On 25th Street

COMMUNITY Outreach & Relations


Outreach & Relations

- Engage Community Outreach & Relation Specialists based in Bayview
- Utilize existing "Neighbors of the Midway" email list & Nextdoor App profile
- Flier extensively through Bayview, Dog Patch, Potrero, and Hunter's Point
- Website with live outreach hotline and specific email address active at least two weeks before, during, and after the event

- Job fair in Bayview and adjacent neighborhoods for hiring on-site positions (hospitality, box office, etc)
- Additionally encourage security and other vendors to host job fairs
- Offer first on-site opportunities to restaurants and cafes in Bayview and adjacent neighborhoods
- Participate in food waste program with local non-profits

Noise Mitigation

 Utilize d&b Sound Systems, specifically to ensure noise bleed to neighborhoods is as minimal as possible.
