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# BCDC AND THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY PLAN

- **BCDC's mission**- protect and enhance San Francisco Bay and encourage the Bay's responsible and productive use for this and future generations.
- **San Francisco Bay Plan**- policies to guide future uses of the Bay and shoreline, and the maps that apply these policies.



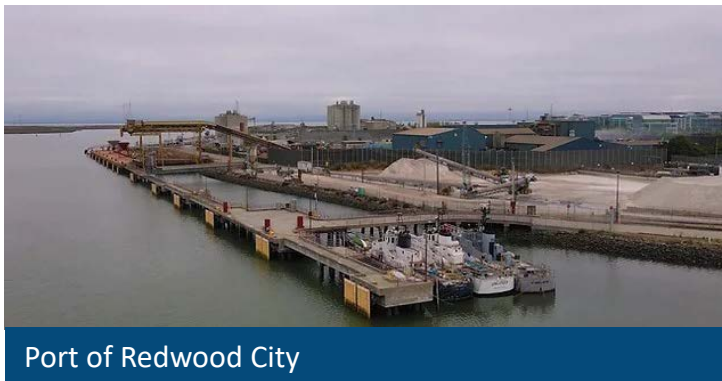
# BAY AREA SEAPORT PLAN

- A specific application of the San Francisco Bay Plan.
- Purpose is to coordinate the planning and development of Bay port terminals to minimize Bay fill.
- First released in 1982; needs a comprehensive update.



# PORT PRIORITY USE AREAS (PPUAs)

- Areas determined necessary for future port development are designated as PPUAs and are reserved for port-related and other uses that will not impede development of the sites for port purposes.
- Informed by the regional Cargo Forecast.



# EXISTING SEAPORT PLAN

## **Part 1: General Policies**

Cargo Forecast, Port Priority Use Areas, Marine Terminals, Container Terminals, Bulk Terminals, Dredging and Navigation, and Ground Transportation.

## **Part 2: Designations**

Contains the port priority use area maps and what marine terminals and types of cargo are being handled.

## **Part 3: Implementation**

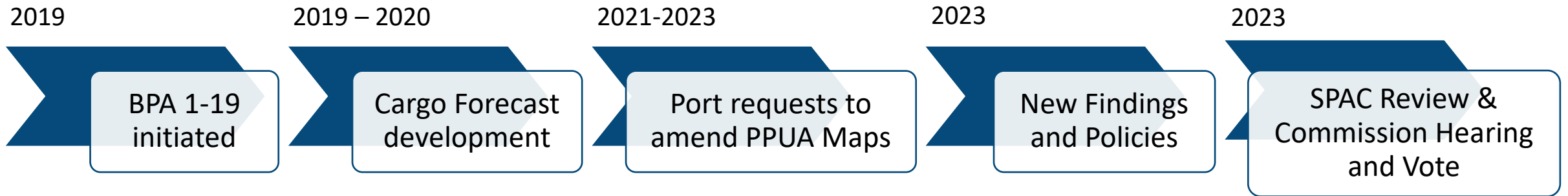
Describes how the Seaport Plan should be implemented and updated in the future.

# SEAPORT PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SPAC)



- Advisory body to the Commission to provide expert advice on seaport related matters.
- Composed of representatives from the five Bay Area Ports, BCDC, MTC/ABAG, the San Francisco Marine Exchange, Caltrans, and Save the Bay.
- Port of SF rep: Andre Coleman.
