SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO THE BUILDING INCLUDED REHABILITATION OF THE EXTERIOR FACADES, CLOCK TOWER, WINDOWS, ETC AND INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Removal of non-historic infill and additions at arcades and entry porticos at primary façade
- Removal of non-historic mezzanine in grand nave
- Restoration of grand nave
- Construction of a compatible but non-historic east façade
- Reconfiguration of ground floor interior spaces
- Addition of openings in second floor to light first floor market hall
- Creation of two outdoor cafe areas at the north and south ends of the building















PROMENADE DIAGRAM Planning Context

KEY PLAN

AREA OVERVIEW

When approaching the Ferry Building you sight on the clock tower at a distance, but as you arrive to the south end of the building, the tower leaves your view and the architecture of the south facade does not provide sufficient orientation. This area south of the building includes: people in transit to and from Ferry gates, the farmer's market, and pedestrians moving towards the water.

The proposed design builds on the WETA Plaza improvements. A cornerstone element built of the WETA Plaza granite flanks the north side of the driveway to frame an arrival towards Ferry Plaza. Movable planters provide greening on non-market days and define the edge of the driveway. Rehabilitated concrete and a new mosaic medallion mark the building entry to the nave. A gateway sign with information about the ferry gates and the name of the Ferry Plaza provides critical orientation information that can be seen from the Embarcadero.

Taken together all of the proposed design elements anchor the existing elements of transportation, retail, and public access by creating important wayfinding and placemaking at the south end of the building.

FERRY PLAZA Proposed Design Narrative



KEY PLAN

AREA OVERVIEW

The Ferry Plaza is home to the Foodwise farmer's market on Saturdays but has struggled to succeed as an active public space on other days of the week. Without clear edges and cues to define the pedestrian space, the plaza can seem like avast area of pavement. In addition, some of the existing furniture elements are disruptive to the easy layout of the farmer's market and the flow of people.

The proposed design frames the plaza area with light poles, a new retail kiosk, and tiered seating. Building on the planning framework begun by WETA Plaza, the linear extension of the pedestrian promenade along the water uses the same light poles and a new tiered seating element to extend your eye towards Treasure Island and the Bay. The retail kiosk is located so as to be seen from the Embarcadero and create interest and draw towards the plaza as well as to minimize its impact to water views. The kiosk location has been determined in concert with Foodwise to mesh into the Market layout. Rehabilitation of the existing concrete pavement of the Ferry Plaza includes grinding the stripes and sealing them to recreate the pavement grid.

These improvements will allow the Ferry Building Events and the Farmer's Market events to continue with ease and will provide a new permanent everyday activation with the kiosk vendor.

AREA OVERVIEW


The bustling activity of the Ferry Building Marketplace has little visibility along the Embarcadero, especially outside of market days and times. The Portico is a dark and uninviting space and gives the impression that the building and marketplace might be closed. Activating the arcade and café zones with restaurant use and seating will engage visitors, customers and the general public throughout the day and expanded evening hours.

Enhancing the Portico lighting and pulling the glass line forward allow more of the Portico to be enclosed and create a more active and comfortable environment for visitors. This approach is consistent with the café zone designation going back to 1990.


Proposed changes along the open-air portions of the north and south arcades introduce operable glazing to provide weather protection and climate control for retail activation. Transparent, operable tenant demising walls will allow continuous views and circulation through the arcade.

At each of the "Café Zones" to the front of the north and south arcades, a freestanding canopy will serve to define seating areas and provide lighting, shade and weather protection, with flexible seating for retail and the public.












BAY FRONT KITCHENS Proposed Design Narrative



AREA OVERVIEW

The central marketplace within the Ferry Building currently has little connection to the waterfront beyond, with long corridors flanked by reflective glazing setting the interior into shadow.

The proposed design seeks to enhance the connection between interior and exterior by removing non-historic partitions to maximize views beyond. Non-historic glazing along the rear façade are replaced by enclosed glass "jewel boxes" with operable glazing to maximize fresh air, natural light and unmatched views of the bay. The existing Central Breezeway is retained as a wide corridor flanked by new public benches.











NORTH ARCADE PROPOSED FARMER'S DAY CIRCULATION







