### OVERVIEW

The objectives of this project are to construct a natural play area (“Rigger’s Yard”), play structure (“Tot Lot”), and dog run at Crane Cove Park. The estimate for construction is \$2 million.

### PROJECT SCOPE

Three play areas will be designed and constructed:

- 1) “Rigger’s Yard” in Crane Cove Park, which is a natural play area in the existing planting areas at the north end of the park.
- 2) “Tot Lot” in Crane Cove Park, which will be in a triangular area already allocated north of Building 49. This will be an area with play structures.
- 3) “Dog Run” on the east side of Crane Cove Park, which is currently an undeveloped area in the former shipyard. This will consist of a fenced-in dog run area, new fencing along the Shipyard, and paving work to create access from the park to the dog run. It will include new lighting.

#### Major Categories of Work

Demolition and Earthwork, Landscaping, Electrical (lighting), Paving, Fencing, Installation of Playground Equipment
