OVERVIEW

The objectives of this project are to construct a natural play area ("Rigger's Yard"), play structure ("Tot Lot"), and dog run at Crane Cove Park. The estimate for construction is \$2 million.

PROJECT SCOPE

Three play areas will be designed and constructed:

- 1) "Rigger's Yard" in Crane Cove Park, which is a natural play area in the existing planting areas at the north end of the park.
- 2) "Tot Lot" in Crane Cove Park, which will be in a triangular area already allocated north of Building 49. This will be an area with play structures.
- 3) "Dog Run" on the east side of Crane Cove Park, which is currently an undeveloped area in the former shipyard. This will consist of a fenced-in dog run area, new fencing along the Shipyard, and paving work to create access from the park to the dog run. It will include new lighting.

Major Categories of Work

Demolition and Earthwork, Landscaping, Electrical (lighting), Paving, Fencing, Installation of Playground Equipment
