Pier 45 Ice Machine Replacement

OVERVIEW

The goal of this project is to ensure the continued use of Fisherman’s Wharf by commercial fishers. The Port will confirm the continuous availability of ice for the commercial fleet during the active fishing season by replacing the existing ice machine at Pier 45 Shed D. The existing ice machine is beyond its useful life.

The estimate for installation is \$250,000.

PROJECT SCOPE

Decommission and remove the existing ice machine at Pier 45 Shed D. Replacement ice machine design to consist of a pair of chiller units with a daily output capacity of 20 to 24 tons (i.e., 40-48 tons total) operating in tandem and a new insulated ice storage bin. A waste ice energy recovery system and a seawater intake system for the harvest of bay water for ice making are optional energy efficiency upgrades to be considered.
