The Contract Monitoring Division ("CMD") has reviewed the proposal received for the above referenced project. The proposal was responsive to pre-award, Chapter14B requirements. Below is a summary of CMD's review.

Rating Bonus

Hollins Consulting is entitled to a rating bonus. At time of proposal Hollins Consulting is a Small LBE firm certified in Administrative Services and Construction Management.

Score Sheets and Score Tabulations

CMD reviewed all score sheets submitted by the technical panelists, the fee schedule submitted by the proposer, and score tabulations submitted by the Port. The final ranking is as follows:

Hollins Consulting	1

The Request for Proposals indicates that the highest qualified scorer will be eligible for contract negotiations and the Port has confirmed that the highest qualified proposer will be selected for negotiations. Hollins Consulting is the sole responsive proposer.

LBE Subconsulting Participation

An LBE subconsulting participation requirement of 20% was established for this project.

Hollins Consulting agreed to achieve the 20% LBE subconsulting participation requirement by subconsulting the following specific services to an LBE:
