Pre-Bid Meeting Questions/Notes

1. What are the steel plate thickness' as the plans do not show?
 - a. Platform walking surface plate is 3/8" per 1/S-402.
 - b. For any other dimensional questions, submit QBD and Port will respond accordingly.
2. Are the bollards part of the scope?
 - a. Yes.
3. What are the requirements for the Al Scoma Way Bridge?
 - a. Truck access is required and must be maintained down Al Scoma Way.
4. Timber Pile removal to be completed by others.
 - a. A dredging contractor will complete under separate contract some time in June 2024.
 - b. Follow-up to be provided with more detail.
5. Does the project have Federal Funding and does this affect OEWD, OLSE and CMD requirements? Does this require Buy America procurement requirements?
 - a. Follow-up to be provided.

Follow-up Items and Clarifications

Pre-bid Item 4:

The dredging and mooring pile removal is planned to be completed by the end of June 2024. Therefore, the window of in-water work for the Phase 1 Float and Gangway project would commence on July 1, 2024. This schedule will be documented and additional information will be provided in a forthcoming addendum.

Pre-bid Item 5:

The project is not subject to Federal Funding requirements. No Buy America or other Federal procurement requirements shall be included in the bids. The CMD and OEWD information that was presented in the January 5, 2024 Pre-Bid meeting is applicable to this project.
