- The overall scope of work entails installation of concrete floats for the berthing of small vessels. The work also includes an alternative to make various repairs to the existing floating end tie dock.

PROJECT SCOPE

- Base Bid Scope:** Construct and Install 350 lineal feet of concrete floats along the north-side of Pier 40. The Contractor will construct the floats to specified lengths in a boatyard and transport them to the site, and then connect them to existing concrete guide piles. Some utility scope is included. The floats will provide berthing for relatively small vessels.
- Additive Alternate Scope:** Make various repairs to the existing floating end-tie docks at the South Beach Marina south of Pier 40.
