## Heron's Head Park – Path Improvements and Electrical Upgrade

### OVERVIEW

Heron's Head Park is located northeast of the intersection of Jennings St. and Cargo Way in India Basin, north of Hunter's Point. The park was designed and constructed in the late 1990's. Improvements were made in 2011 and 2012, which included site clearing, demolition, grading and drainage, metal fencing, concrete work, irrigation, landscaping, site furnishings, self-composting restrooms, electrical work, and paving. Currently, there is another ongoing project at the site to perform shoreline restoration.

Upgrades to the EcoCenter and paths at Heron's Head Park will be performed as part of this project. The Heron's Head Park project is in the initial phases of design. The total construction budget for this contract is approximately \$1 million.

### PROJECT SCOPE

Included in the scope is construction of an ADA-accessible secondary path connecting the EcoCenter to the PG&E shoreline, updating path signage, installation of a habitat protection fence, installation of path lighting

connecting the parking lot to the EcoCenter, installing new solar panels to the EcoCenter, and other related electrical work.

3. Fencing
4. Electrical
