

Port of San Francisco Hyde Street Harbor Repair and Improvements

OVERVIEW

The project will seek to repair and improve Hyde Street Harbor

PROJECT SCOPE

The floating docks at the Hyde Street Harbor Pier in Fisherman's Wharf, constructed in early 2000s, are failing and in need of major repairs. Scope of work will include, but is not limited to the following:

- 1. Repair or replacement of existing piles, ladders, pile covers, pile guide rollers, timber whalers and concrete floats
- 2. Electrical upgrades to the pier structure
- 3. The removal of three existing concrete piles to provide more maneuverability for larger boats.
- 4. Improvement of the cleat system and strengthen the floats to accommodate larger vessels currently berthing at the Pier.
- 5. Repair and upgrade the mechanical systems including water and fire lines.

The total construction budget for this project is \$1.5M* with an anticipated minimum LBE subcontracting requirement of 20% *
