


Economic Impact Policy: Goal

Leverage the Port's economic activity to advance social equity and inclusion for communities in and neighboring the Port, including historically disadvantaged communities, through Port contracts, improvements to open space, port and tenant hiring, and leasing.



Economic Impact Policy: Process

- Gather input from public, staff, and community advisory committees on how to improve economic impact to disadvantaged communities
- Present final ideas to Port
 Commission for approval
- Set implementable goals, establish metrics, and monitor progress





Public and Staff input on four levers

Contracts (July – August)

Parks and Open Space (September – October)

Port and Tenant Hiring (November – December)

Leases (January – February)



Lever 1: Contracts

- Create Port specific pre-qualified contractor pool
- Pier 70 Shipyard Repurposing Concept
- Increase presence and accessibility to Port staff in the community





Lever 2: Parks and Open Space

- Propose additional internal staffing support
- Create park evaluation standards
- Launch marketing and communications strategy to engage local residents with parks





Lever 3: Port and Tenant Hiring

- Currently pursuing 7-week meeting series with internal and external stakeholders to understand the barriers to employment and retention at the Port
- Analysis of port and tenant job opportunities, apprenticeships, internships and marketing





Lever 4: Leasing

- Currently exploring opportunities to increase engagement and participation in leasing
- Internal and external stakeholder meetings starting in January
