
CONTINUITY

Develop a continuous waterfront walkway that connects public access, open spaces and activity areas from Fisherman's Wharf to Pier 70.




VARIETY

Develop a variety of public access and open spaces that offer many recreational opportunities and enhance other uses along the waterfront.




Hard-scaped plazas, such as the Ferry Building plaza, have different qualities and opportunites for programming than vegetated open spaces.










DIVERSITY OF ACTIVITIES

The Port is home to a wide mix of maritime, open space, commercial and other public and revenue generating uses.








COMPLETE STREETS & TRANSPORTATION

A civic waterfront boulevard and neighborhood streets that serve Port tenants, commuters, visitors, and provide safe access for all.










Ceremonial/Civic

Ceremonial streets are grand civic spaces which serve as major gathering spots for marches, parades, and rallies, and serve as world renowned public spaces and attractions. Ceremonial streets should be uniquely designed in each case; they should exhibit a high degree of design consistency, formality, and care.





Embarcadero Street Section






