PIER 94 BIOBLITZ: BE A SCIENTIST FOR A DAY APRIL 1 9:00AM-1:00PM

Please note: this event meets at Pier 94, 480 Amador Street, at 9 am sharp. After we are done blitzing, we will move to the EcoCenter at Heron's Head Park for a plant and animal identification party. Please provide your own transportation; the trip is a 15-minute walk or a 3 minute drive.

In collaboration with Golden Gate Audubon and the California Academy of Sciences, join us for a grassroots BioBlitz at Pier 94, where nature—with the help of hardworking Golden Gate Audubon volunteers—is reclaiming a hidden wetland consisting of nearly five acres of isolated industrial land on San Francisco's southern waterfront. A BioBlitz is an intensive one-day study of life forms in a particular location. We'll look for birds, mammals, fish, reptiles, butterflies, insects, spiders, trees, flowers, mushrooms...anything that is alive! Come help practicing scientists gather information that could be used for formal, scientific research. People of all ages and skill levels are welcome. You bring your curiosity and, if you have one handy, a smartphone or a digital camera. We'll rally some experts and folks who know the area. Together we'll make science!
